The subject was raised about installing one or more fountains in the resaca. It was brought up that this issue had been referred to the Park Board in the past, and the cost benefit analysis was that the Park Board would not approve a fountain in the resaca.

A question was raised about sharing Rec Club information on the Park's website. Concern was raised about Rec information being open to the

general public. This issue will be sent to the Rec Executive Board for further investigation, and brought back to the Club at its next meeting.

Question was raised concerning the Club purchasing a larger TV for the Thomas Center. Subject was left to the Rec President to investigate, and brought back to the Club at its next meeting.

Question was asked if there would be a patio sale this year. The President's answer was no.

Question was asked about the capabilities of the TV in the Game Room. Questions about the TV's operation should be raised with the Game Room Coordinator, Dan Zimmerman.
