January 13, 2026**

The meeting called to order 11:28 am by Dave Jacobsen

Minutes: As posted moved Dave Jacobsen moved 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dan Zimmerman all approved.

Treasurers Report: reported by Bonnie Stanley year to date is \$483.68 with Club balance of \$13,563. Dave Jacobsen moved to approve 2nd Lori Bradford all approved.

Old Business: The room divider now works, and the speakers will be adjusted to match the room division on Friday. Any expenses will be covered by the Park board.

New Business: A motion was made by Lori Bradford with a 2<sup>nd</sup> to purchase new roasters each season not to exceed the spending limit of \$300 of the Council, and older roasters of the same number to be sold.  
There was discussion regarding the age of current roasters, and should they begin to be replaced?  
All approved the motion and the Kitchen Coordinator was directed to purchase the roasters.

Square and Compass events are slowly being reduced. As Square and Compass was in existence before the Rec Club and has no desire to become part of the Rec Club; It was suggested that some of those events might be taken over by the Club. Should coordinators be found to head some of those events, the Rec Council would welcome those additions. No action was taken on this subject.

Kitchen Coordinator Linda Rogalsky made a motion that food trucks should be invited to the Park during the Patio Sale motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> . Discussion concerned the difficulties experienced the last time food trucks were at the park. It was noted that trucks need to supply their own electrical supply using generators. It was also noted that the parking area for the trucks should be under the direction of the Park Manager to consider traffic patterns and lines at the trucks. A suggestion was also made that Elnora Colley could be consulted as she arranged the last visit from food trucks. The motion was passed. All approved.
